PLATINUM \$1950 PER QUARTER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50 Meal Counts • \$990 Ala Carte • \$200 Eagle Flex 	Meal plan change allowed for current and future quarters.
GOLD \$1615 PER QUARTER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30 Meal Counts • \$995 Ala Carte • \$50 Eagle Flex 	Meal plan change allowed for current and future quarters.

NOTES: Your purchased meal plan is accessible via your Eagle ID Card. In order to qualify for Sign Up Bonuses you must select and maintain a Gold plan, Platinum plan or either Unlimited plans. All meal plan change requests will be processed after the second full week of each quarter.

ALA-CARTE

Ala-Carte is a penny-a-point system that allows you to purchase items at any Dining location without tax. **Ala-Carte carries over quarter to quarter and expires at end of the academic school year.**

FLEX DOLLARS

A flex account is a prepaid, debit-like feature on your Eagle Card. It is great for staff and students who want the advantage of a meal plan without having to carry cash. A flex account can be opened by anyone with a current Eagle Card. Money can be added to a flex account by going to the Tawanka Business Office, calling 509.359.2540 or going to ewu.edu/myeaglecard - We accept Visa or Mastercard. **Flex carries over year to year.**

MEAL COUNTS

Meal counts are primarily used at Tawanka Main Street Dining and are a count-per-meal system. These can be used at Tawanka Main St. Dining and Dining special events. Look for our meal count extravaganza at the end of each quarter to use your remaining meal counts! **Meal counts expire at the end of each quarter.**

UNLIMITED

By choosing one of the EWU Dining Services Unlimited Access Plans, students will have unlimited access to Tawanka Main Street Dining. During normal operating hours, students will have the flexibility to visit this location as often as they like; whenever they are hungry, want a place to socialize or need a quick snack. Main Street Dining will serve breakfast, lunch and dinner and feature EWU Classics, Southwestern, American and International recipes. Salads, pizza, pasta, and desserts are all available. The Unlimited Access Plan is a great value, allowing students to eat as often as they want throughout the day. The Unlimited plan will feature two levels: Unlimited and Unlimited Plus. The Unlimited plan offers the value of unlimited access to Main Street Dining and a limited amount of flexible spending at Dining Services retail locations. The Unlimited Plus plan also allows unlimited access to Mains Street Dining but offers a much larger amount of flexible spending at retail locations. Both plans are an excellent value and allow students flexible spending options at Dining Service's locations.

Unlimited meal plans cannot be changed mid-quarter.
